**ROOFER CONVICTED OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION VIOLATIONS**

Attorney General William H. Sorrell announced today that Glenn Vaillancourt, age 60, of St. Albans, Vermont, pled guilty on October 16, 2007 in Franklin County District Court to four misdemeanor charges of failing to obtain workers' compensation insurance for his employees in connection with his work on roofing jobs in Highgate Center, Alburg, South Burlington, and Derby. Mr. Vaillancourt received a sentence of 0 to 36 months, all suspended, with 120 hours of community service. The Court ordered the standard conditions of probation along with a special condition that Mr. Vaillancourt comply with the workers' compensation laws on any future roofing contracts.
